Who is it For?

The level 2 Certificate is aimed at managers, supervisors, team leaders, department heads requiring gaining practical understanding of health and safety, and equipping them to undertake a realistic, workplace related assessment that leads to a level 2 qualification.

How does it Work?

The course can be delivered on site at companies' premises or at our training centre in Redditch. The syllabus is delivered over a 3 days.
